You can easily add CAP to your existing will by filling out a Codicil form.

You can download one by visiting **capnz.org/legacy** or simply emailing the CAP team.

It may be best to do this with a solicitor or qualified will writer to ensure it is legally valid.

Remember to update your will as your circumstances change to make sure it accurately reflects your wishes.
