CAP’s free services are run in partnership with local churches around the country, so a team is present in communities to walk alongside people.

Your ‘Tomorrow’ gift will change more lives like Alan and Delwyn’s.

Every day, New Zealanders in hardship reach out for help. CAP answers their call by partnering with churches across Aotearoa, bringing the love of God in practical ways.

With the vital support and financial resilience you enable, people are released to focus on what’s most important to them.

CAP offers two free services – CAP Debt Help (for people in unmanageable debt) and CAP Money (a money management course).

CAP Debt Help starts with local CAP Debt Coaches visiting people in their homes.

The CAP Team then liaises with people's creditors, getting things like unfair interest written off. They create budgets prioritising essentials like food and rent, and including savings. CAP provides support on many levels... until people are ready to manage on their own – free from unmanageable debt and empowered with money skills.

Thousands of New Zealanders have now left CAP financially resilient and released to pursue their whānau goals for the future!

Importantly, through their CAP journey, all encounter the love of God; many take steps closer to Him.



CAP Money courses empower people with tools to help them spend, budget, and save wisely.

Even better, through CAP Money, people have the opportunity to walk through the doors of their local church.



Delwyn and Alan's story

Alan and Delwyn are now debt free... and their lives are turned around completely!

The parents of three children reflect that their money chaos 'cut across everything', including their relationship: "There was always something hanging over us." Delwyn called CAP after their card was declined at the supermarket...

Now that they're free from unmanageable debt, Alan shares:

"We're able to be the people we want to be.... And the kids have got savings, they understand the value of money."
